Biography

In 1925 Emil SCHÜTT applied for a patent as representative of “*Reklame Verlag Emil Schütt*”, with a reference to “*Druckerei NIMAX Ed.*”, situated in 12 rue Wiltheim in Luxembourg-city. ¹

SCHÜTT had created a train timetable design which was manufactured by the “*Druckerei NIMAX Ed.*”

He was probably of French origin (Alsace?). ²

In April 1926 he was reported to be representative of “*Aux Classes Laborieuses*”, a household-selling company in Luxembourg-gare. ³

It would appear that Emil SCHÜTT resided in Esch sur Alzette in 1927. ⁴
